

Landing Will Signal Return Of Prisoners

MANILA, Aug. 27.—(AP)—Allied headquarters announced tonight that rapid evacuation of thousands of Allied prisoners of war will begin "almost simultaneously" with the entry of occupation forces into Japan.

There are believed to be about 1,000 Canadian prisoners in Japanese camps.

Mighty Superforts which had rained death on Japan became winged angels of mercy today and dropped food to Allied prisoners of war at Weihsein, China.

Prime Minister King Sunday night made public a message he sent to released Canadian prisoners of war and civilian internees formerly held by the Japanese promising that "every possible measure is being taken to ensure your early repatriation and the restoration in fullest measure of your health, strength and peace of heart and mind."
